
Survey Overview

49% It's okay but there are things I would change


40% I avoid it or think changes are needed now


State Street is part of my neighborhood and I travel or cross it regularly I use it to reach destinations outside of Boise










Walking and Biking on State Street

What would get you to walk or bike more often?




